- Serve as the authorized signature for validation of completed work, authorizing progression to subsequent project phases physically, on PMIS and in SAP.

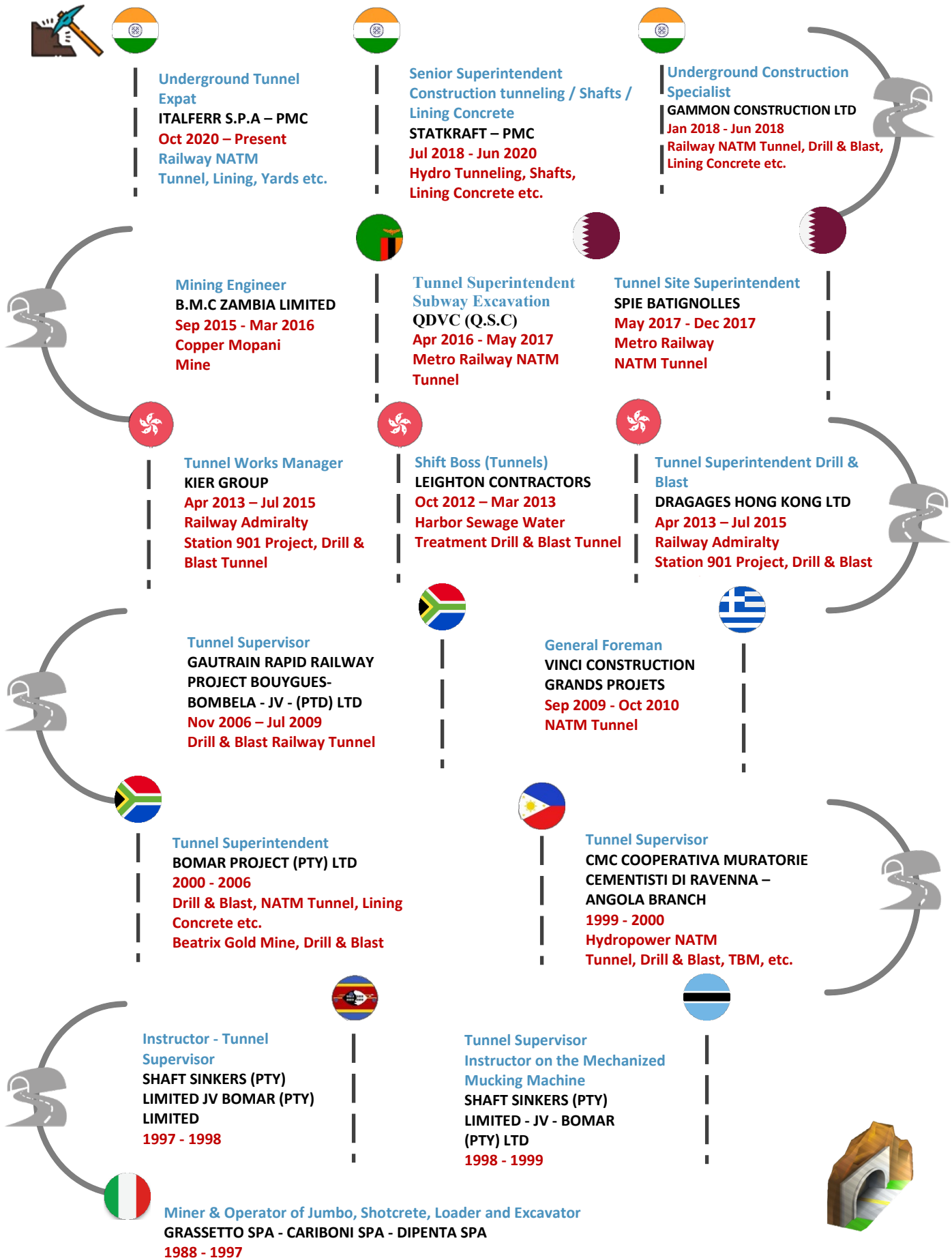
